Side Letter FAQs Updated: March 15, 2022

Topic: Duty Day

- Teachers may leave campus after the end of their instructional day.
 - Classroom teachers have the option to leave after the conclusion of instruction on days where there are no nuts-and-bolts meetings and all professional duties have been fulfilled (IEPs, school dismissal responsibilities, parent contacts/meetings, admin conversations, etc).
 - When the Fresno County metrics for daily new cases per 100k is less than 5.9% and the positivity rate is less than 4.9% for three consecutive weeks, teachers will revert back the duty day/work day per the CBA.

Duty Day FAQs

- Q. On a minimum day, may I leave campus after instruction?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Is it ok for my site admin. to change previously scheduled minimum days to a regular day schedule?
- A. No. This is not within the spirit of the agreement. Please contact your FTA staff representative if this happens.
- Q. When my school has a late start in order to have a meeting, am I required to attend?
- A. No, unless the meeting is one of the four nuts and bolts staff meetings allowed this semester.

Topic: PL/PLC Meetings

- All remaining scheduled PL/PLC meetings are optional for teachers to attend.
 - There shall not be disciplinary action or implied disciplinary action for not attending PL/PLC meetings.
 - When the Fresno County metrics for daily new cases per 100k is less than 2 and the positivity rate is less than 2%, we will revert back the 2020-21 side letter and the agreed upon remaining scheduled PL/PLC hours.
- Site administration may schedule up to four (4) Nuts and Bolts meetings during the remainder of the 2nd semester.

Note: Designated Schools are still responsible for the designated PL/PLC hours that they are being compensated for, for the remainder of the year.

PL/PLC Meetings FAQs

- Q. Can my site admin. control the PLC agenda?
- A. No. The decision on if and when to meet, plus the topics of conversation are at the discretion of the teacher.
- Q. My site admin. told me that some PL/PLC meetings are still required. Is that true?
- No. All PL/PLC meetings are optional.

Topic: Buyback

• March 21, 2022: Admin time is <u>up to</u> 2 hours. Remainder of the day is teacher time to plan and perform their professional responsibilities, <u>as determined by the teachers</u>.

Buyback FAQs

- Q. What can I do with the time after the two hour admin. limit?
- A. You have discretion to use that time in a way that you feels best meets your professional responsibilities (i.e. lesson planning, grading, meeting with colleagues, etc.)
- Q. Is it ok for my site admin. to schedule PLCs after their two hour limit?
- A. Site admin. can't require attendance because individual teachers have discretion on what to do with their time.
 - 1. All PLC meetings are optional.
 - 2. All the time after the two hour limit is at the discretion of the teacher.

Substitute Coverage

- Site Admin and/or department supervisors may ask teachers to substitute for an uncovered class (or to receive deployed elementary students).
- While we recognize that teachers have an option, the District and FTA encourage all teachers to lean in and assist when and where they can.
 - Per article 39, the district may require teachers to cover classes for teachers in case of emergencies.
 - Site administration and/or department supervisors will explore additional options beyond an assigned classroom teacher covering the classroom before requiring the teacher to cover or receive deployed students.
- If a teacher accepts this request, secondary teachers covering a class period during their prep and elementary teachers receiving deployed students will receive 1 hour of per diem pay.
 - Teachers will receive retroactive compensation to Aug. 12, 2021.
